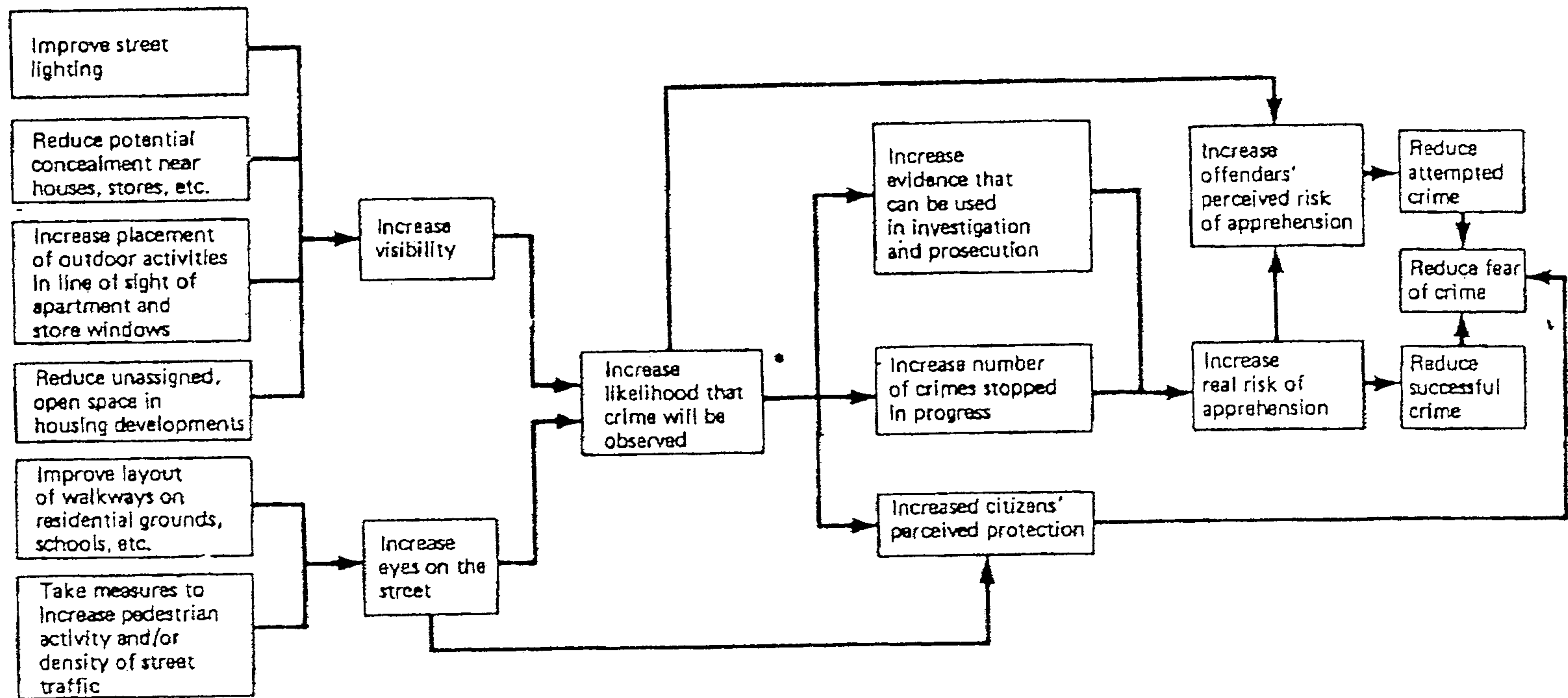


The Evidence for the Social Surveillance Rationale
