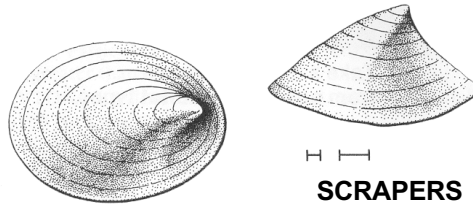


KEY TO FUNCTIONAL FEEDING GROUPS

— Indicates size or range of sizes

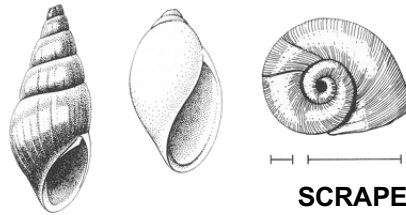
1. ANIMALS IN HARD SHELL (Phylum Mollusca)

a. LIMPETS (Class Gastropoda)



SCRAPERS

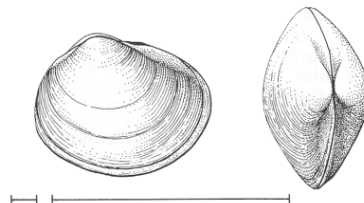
b. SNAILS (Class Gastropoda)



SCRAPERS

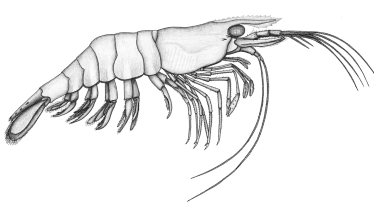
Snails are generalized (facultative) feeders and can also function as Shredders.

c. CLAMS OR MUSSELS (Class Pelecypoda)



FILTERING COLLECTORS

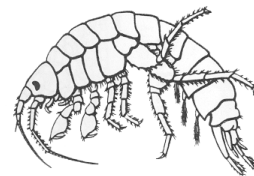
2. SHRIMP-LIKE ANIMALS (Class Crustacea)

SHREDDERS

Can also function as facultative Gathering Collectors

3. LARVAE IN PORTABLE CASE OR "HOUSE".

Go to KEY 2

4. LARVAE IN FIXED RETREAT WITH CAPTURE NET.

Go to KEY 3

Note: Care must be taken when collecting to observe nets

5. WITHOUT CASE OR FIXED RETREAT.

a. WORM-LIKE LARVAE, WITHOUT JOINTED LEGS.

Go to KEY 4

b. NYMPHS OR ADULTS WITH JOINTED LEGS.

Go to KEY 5

6. DOES NOT FIT KEY 5 EXACTLY.

Go to KEY 6
or KEY 7
